Nothing in the above excludes or limits any liability which it would be unlawful for GB Railfreight to exclude, including liability in respect of title to dispose of the locomotives.

Successful bidder(s), if any, will be required to remove the locomotives from site at their own cost and at times agreed with GB Railfreight.

**GB Railfreight reserves the absolute and unfettered right, at its sole discretion, to:**

- Withdraw any or all locomotives from sale at any time
- Elect not to proceed with a sale
- Reject any or all registrations, submissions, indicative offers, or tenders (whether received before or after any stated deadline)
- Accept or reject (at its discretion) any registration or submission received after a stated closing date
- Amend the process or timetable at any time
- Negotiate with any party
- Shortlist bidders
- Award or decline to award a contract for any reason

No liability shall arise to any actual or prospective bidder in respect of any such decision.

## **TENDER PROCESS & KEY DATES**

Stage 1 – Registration & Indicative Offer

Deadline: 05/03/2026

Following closure of the registration period, ITT documentation will be issued to selected registered parties at GB Railfreight's sole discretion.

## **STAGE 2 – FORMAL OFFER SUBMISSION**

Registered parties must:

- Undertake a site viewing (by prior arrangement only)
- Submit their formal offer
- Sign and return the ITT documentation

Deadline for formal offer submission: 20/03/2026

Failure to meet this deadline may result in exclusion from further participation. However, GB Railfreight reserves the right, at its sole discretion, to accept or reject any late formal offer.

## **STAGE 3 – SHORTLISTING & BAFO**

GB Railfreight may shortlist suppliers at its sole discretion.

Shortlisted parties will be contacted directly and invited to submit a Best and Final Offer (BAFO).

GB Railfreight reserves the right to:

- Conduct one or more BAFO rounds
- Conclude negotiations without requesting BAFO
- Enter negotiations with one or more parties
- Discontinue the process at any stage

## **AWARD**

If GB Railfreight elects to proceed with a sale, a contract may be awarded to the party or parties selected at its sole discretion, considering financial and non-financial considerations including (but not limited to):

- Overall value offered
- Speed of site clearance
- Payment terms
- Commercial terms
- Operational and compliance considerations
